Suites, 1500 Arlington Blvd., Arlington, VA, Rosslyn Metro Stop (Blue or Orange Lines).

Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> Morning and early afternoon registration at Virginian Suites. Late afternoon Reception (4:00-6:00 or 4:30-6:30 tbd) for Arkadaşlar at the Turkish Ambassador's Residence (Sheridan Circle & Massachusetts, Ave., NW, in DC). Parking is not available so we will need to take a taxi or take the Metro, DuPont Circle Stop (Red Line) and walk 1/3 mile northwest up Massachusetts Ave. to Ambassador's Residence on Sheridan Circle. Attire is business casual - (men - sport coat & tie, and women - pants suit or dress). Participation is likely to be limited. Admittance will be reserved for the first persons to register.

Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>: Peace Corps Staff Reunion. All RPCVs welcome. (7:00-10:00 PM) A special evening event with Peace Corps Directors from all decades, RPCV current and former Members of Congress and other luminaries, Peace Corps staff and volunteers from over 50 years and many who served in Turkey! At the historic National Building Museum, 401 F. St., NW, in DC next to the Judiciary Square Metro stop (Red Line). On-street parking, Metro or taxi. Admission is \$60 and includes light buffet and *hors d'oeuvres*, wine, beer and soft drinks. **Saturday, September 24<sup>th</sup> Afternoon:** Arkadaşlar Plenary Session (1:30-4:30 PM) in the Potomac Ballroom of the Key Bridge Marriott Hotel, 1401 Lee Hwy., Arlington (Rosslyn), VA. It is a few blocks' walk from the Rosslyn Metro Stop (Blue or Orange Lines). There will be speakers, exhibits, display tables for each Turkey group, and Turkish items for sale. Parking is available at a cost of \$6. Take the parking ticket to the receptionist at the front desk to be validated before, during, or after the meeting.

**Saturday, September 24<sup>th</sup> Evening:** dinner get-togethers by Arkadaşlar groups (T1 – T17). Group Coordinators will advise each group of the place, time and cost.

**Saturday, September 24<sup>th</sup> Evening:** Promise of the Peace Corps Gala (7:00-10:00) sponsored by NPCA. Black tie. Cost is \$250 for NPCA members and \$300 for non-members. At the Ronald Reagan Building, 13<sup>th</sup> & Pennsylvania Ave., NW in DC. On street parking, taxi or Metro to Federal Triangle Stop (Blue or Orange Lines). **Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup> Morning:** ceremony (10:00-12:00) at Arlington National Cemetery and Amphitheater honoring Peace Corps accomplishments and those who died in service, wreath-laying at John F. Kennedy's gravesite, and Procession of the Peace Corps Country Flags across the Memorial Bridge to the Mall. Those Arkadaşlar ready, willing, and able will march behind the Turkish Flag about 2.5 miles to the Mall. As in the past, we will vary the flag carrier. Parking is available, take a taxi, or take the Metro to Arlington National Cemetery Stop (Blue Line).

**Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup> Afternoon:** exhibits, mini-demonstrations, entertainment and a closing NPCA ceremony on the Mall (12:00-3:00). On-street parking, taxi or take the Metro to the Smithsonian Stop (Blue or Orange Lines).
